Teachers facilitate student learning by using a range of data as well as continuous assessment and reporting practices

1. Teachers connect with their students on a one to one level to develop positive relationships within a 21st Century Learning Environment, including 'Student Voice', and focus on:
 - Critical Thinking
 - Collaboration
 - Creative Problem Solving
 - Communication
2. Teachers and Students endorse "The Wellington Way" and the Code of Conduct to provide a safe and orderly environment
3. Teachers monitor attendance and follow up on identified wellbeing and academic concerns
4. Teachers adopt consistent teaching and learning protocols by facilitating:
 - Learning Intentions
 - Success Criteria
 - 'Do Now' Activities for Effective Writing
 - Timely Feedback for Improvement
 - Reflection Time
 - High Impact Teaching Strategies
5. Teachers document and facilitate differentiated teaching and learning
6. Students come to class with the appropriate resources ready to learn
7. Students are empowered to clarify understanding, ask questions and achieve their potential
