## Guide to Continuous Assessment & Reporting

All subjects from 7 to 10 are assessed using the Victorian Curriculum 7 to 10 as well as the Wellington SC Levels of Performance Matrix. The Matrix is used to assess summative tasks such as examinations and common assessment tasks in Years 7 to 11.

Performance Level	Description	% Range
<b>Outstanding</b>	The student has demonstrated a detailed and sophisticated understanding of the concepts and skills, and has expressed their knowledge with complexity, creativity and confidence.	90 - 100
<b>Excellent</b>	The student has demonstrated a comprehensive understanding of the concepts and skills, and has used their knowledge to critically evaluate material, and express their knowledge in an insightful way.	80 - 89
<b>Very Good</b>	The student has demonstrated a strong understanding of concepts and skills, and has consistently and effectively applied this knowledge to new learning.	70 - 79
<b>Good</b>	The student has demonstrated a sound understanding of concepts and skills, and has applied this knowledge to new learning.	60 - 69
<b>Acceptable</b>	The student has displayed a basic understanding of concepts and skills, and has demonstrated that understanding in a reasonable way.	50 - 59
<b>Barely Acceptable</b>	The student has shown a limited understanding of concepts and skills and has communicated their knowledge, but at a very low level.	40 - 49
<b>Not Satisfactory</b>	The student has not shown a meaningful understanding of concepts and skills nor demonstrated their understanding in a coherent or logical way.(or the work was not submitted for other than an approved reason)	0 -39
<b>Not Assessed</b>	The student has been unable to submit the task for assessment for an approved reason or the task was not formally assessed.	NA
<b>Modified Task</b>	For approved students only	M

### VCE Subjects

The award of a satisfactory completion for a Unit is based on a decision that the student has demonstrated achievement of the set of outcomes specified for the Unit. The decision is based on assessment of the student's overall performance in course work and assessment tasks.

An **Outcome** is what the student must know or be able to do by the time they have finished a VCE unit. **Course work** comprises of the tasks mainly completed in class and assessed to determine the student's individual level of performance.

**S** The student has demonstrated achievement of the set of outcomes specified for the Unit.  
The student has produced work that meets the required standard

**N** The student has not demonstrated achievement of all or some of the set of outcomes specified for the Unit  
The student has produced work that does not meet the required standard.
